I attempt to get into a calm and quiet state, where I am aware of every sound in the environment. I follow these with my hand and ears. Each breath is a sound event. I try to resist the temptation to attend to one thing.

To avoid getting stuck on my own breathing or the birds or any other single sound. To be present I keep my ears as open as possible. Every sound occurring is important. If my attention flows fast enough sometimes I even have the feeling everything becomes one. For me field recording is more than just the recording itself. It's something that has to be experienced. Sometimes I stand in the field with closed eyes and in every moment I move gently but silently. I never stop moving. Small movements, that you may not even see.

We never give attention to the hum. It's always around, constant, unconscious. We only spot it once it stops. Air conditioning consumes 10% of the global electricity production, has a huge impact on the global CO₂ emission and is also responsible for the elevation of temperatures, releasing hot air in its environment. To me, the hum is the symbolic sound for global warming.

Online, many people find comfort and appeasement in the sounds of the air conditioners. In the installation, you will be listening to a slow meditative composed soundscape of ventilations from Zürich, mixed with found anonymous comments under air conditioners videos on YouTube, revealing the ambiguous affective connection we can develop towards the "hums". The musical tones you will hear are the result of the "de-hum" software I usually apply to clean field recordings; by using it the other way around, it keeps only what the software calculates as hums. [SHIFTING FOCUS] is developed through the practice of field recording. It encourages listeners to become aware of their environment, to be present and to be open, without expectation.

The piece begins with a humming, noisy sound environment with no hints to a specific place into meandering sinus waves that open up a more tonal space. Additional high frequencies lead into field recordings of trains and cars and ending with a birdscape of Wauwiler Moos. The following field note was written after the making of the birdscapes recordings which appear at the end of this piece. It gives an impression of the process of making these field recordings.

"Car noises in the background. Birds singing vividly. I hear myself."

Two omnidirectional microphones attached to my bag, a shotgun microphone in my hand. I try to follow the birds with my mic and at the same time I try not to move too much to avoid handling noise. Any sound of my movements become foregrounded on the recording because I am close to the mic.

I attempt to get into a calm and quiet state, where I am aware of every sound in the environment. I follow these with my hand and ears. The end of the piece is a sign of the reality coming back in form of the many constructions site and its noises we are facing every day in our daily life.









SCANVISION is an ETH Spinoff, specialised in 3D Documentation and Visualisation of landscape, architecture and arts using laser scanning and photogrammetry.

Founded in January 2018, the brilliance of SCANVISION's work is based on many years of experience with point clouds at the Chair of Landscape Architecture Christophe Girot at ETH Zurich coupled with strong skills in conceptual, spatial and cinematic thinking. The boundaries of surveying and representation are constantly being explored and new ways of conveying spatial information are being developed. The scope of possibilities is constantly being expanded through new surveying methods, workflows and the development of sensor-based interfaces.

Our work includes the surveying, documentation and visualisation of art objects, complex urban situations, large-scale landscapes, underground infrastructures and more. With the help of surveying methods, such as 3D laser scanners, spaces are captured efficiently and in high detail. Digital models are made accessible through a wide variety of representations adapted to specific needs.

The media-effective reproduction techniques range from high-resolution films to VR and AR applications to interactive programs and convey a spatial experience to the viewer. We show the relationship of places, infrastructures, objects and spaces in a new way.





Klatschend passen die Handflächen perfekt aufeinander und doch beginnen sie irgendwann wehzutzen.
